Traditional Costumes

Every country in the world has a traditional costume. People wear these costumes every day or for special celebrations. In Mexico it is very hot and the traditional clothes help people stay cool. Men wear big hats and large cotton clothes. Women and little girls wear long colourful dresses, and flowers in their hair.
